

What is Human Trafficking?

Human trafficking is when someone is exploited for labor or sex through force, fraud, or coercion OR when someone under 18 is participating in commercial sex.

Some examples:

- Forced labor
- Survival Sex (under 18 years old)
- Forced prostitution
- Tricked into prostitution or a job through a fraudulent job offer
- Lured into prostitution through drug addiction
